

## AIM 3.0 – Allowing Pop-ups Guide

Davies offers online access through the AIM 3.0 website.

Please Note: Pop-ups **must** be allowed for the Aim 3.0 website to function properly.

Chrome is the preferred web browser to use while using AIM 3.0.

Firefox or Microsoft Edge are also acceptable web browsers.

AIM 3.0 will not function properly in Internet Explorer.

### Pop-ups Overview:

Several functions in AIM 3.0 rely upon pop-up windows to prompt users for input which directs the site to know what action should be taken in given situations. For example a pop-up will appear after submitting a new Workers Compensation claim prompting the user to printing the injury report. By default, this pop-up is blocked and will cause AIM 3.0 to be unable to generate the necessary report.

### Logging In to AIM 3.0:

1) Access AIM 3.0 through one of the following:

2) Login with your AIM username and password.

- You will be required to change any temporary passwords upon logging in.
- You can use the Forgot Password button to unlock your AIM account by sending a temporary password to the email account associated with your AIM account.




## Allowing Pop-ups in Google Chrome:

- Allow Pop-ups - Method 1:

- i. In the upper right corner of Chrome if you see this small button icon with a red box and white x, then a pop-up has been blocked. If this box does not appear or you do not see it, try Method 2 below.




- ii. Clicking the button above will bring up the Chrome 'Pop-ups blocked' window. To allow AIM 3.0 pop-ups, select the 'Allows allow pop-ups and redirects' option and click 'Done'




### Allow Pop-ups - Method 2:

- iii. If you were successful in allowing pop-ups in Chrome method 1, you do not have to complete Method 2.
- iv. In the upper right corner of Chrome, click the 3 vertical dots.
- v. Click Settings




vi. In the top search bar of the settings window, type 'pop' or 'pop-up'




vii. Under Privacy and Security, click 'Site Settings'

viii. In the Site Settings window, scroll down the page and click 'Pop-ups and redirects'



ix. In the Pop-ups and redirects window, next to 'Allow', click add.

1. There are two add buttons, please ensure the 2<sup>nd</sup> add button next to Allow is pressed and not the 1<sup>st</sup> Allow button next to Block.



x. Type or copy/paste "johnseasternenterprise.jw-filehandler.com" (without quotation marks) into the Add a site pop-up window and click the Add button.



## Allowing Pop-ups in Firefox:

- Allow Pop-ups - Method 1:




- In the top center of Firefox if you see this yellow bar, then a pop-up has been blocked.




- Clicking the options button will bring up the Firefox 'Pop-ups blocked' menu. To allow AIM 3.0 pop-ups, click the 'Allows allow pop-ups' option

- Allow Pop-ups - Method 2:


- If you were successful in allowing pop-ups in Firefox method 1, you do not have to complete Method 2.
- In the upper right corner of Firefox, click the 3 horizontal lines.
- Click Options



- iv. In the top search bar of the settings window, type 'pop' or 'pop-up'
- v. Under Search Results, click 'Exceptions' next to Block pop-up windows




- vi. In the Pop-ups and redirects window, next to 'Allow', click add.




- vii. Type or copy/paste "johnseasterneenterprise.jw-filehandler.com" (without quotation marks) into the Address of website field and click the Allow button. The AIM 3.0 address will appear twice, once beginning with 'http' and once beginning with 'https'. Click the Save Changes button.

## Allowing Pop-ups in Microsoft Edge:

- Allow Pop-ups - Method 1:




- In the upper right corner of Microsoft Edge if you see this small button icon with a red box and white x, then a pop-up has been blocked. If this box does not appear or you do not see it, try Method 2 below.
- Clicking the button above will bring up Edge's 'Pop-ups blocked' window. To allow AIM 3.0 pop-ups, select the 'Always allow pop-ups and redirects' option and click 'Done'




- Allow Pop-ups - Method 2:

- If you were successful in allowing pop-ups in Microsoft Edge in method 1, you do not have to complete Method 2.
- In the upper right corner of Edge, click the 3 horizontal dots.
- Click Settings



- iv. In the side search bar of the settings window, type 'pop' or 'pop-up'
- v. In the Search Results scroll down until you see "Pop-ups and redirects".
- vi. Click on "Pop-ups and redirects".



- vii. In the Pop-ups and redirects window, next to 'Allow', click the Add button.
